All firms must be Pre-Qualified with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), and all sub-contractors must be registered with GDOT. Statements shall be identified on the exterior of the sealed envelope with all the information required by law, including the name of the project and the Respondent's name, address and license number, expiration date and classification (as applicable).
