Report Highlight: Turnipseed Engineering has completed their Feasibility Study on the Porter Village/Summit Area of town. This mainly looked at the Ranger Camp Lift Station operations. Total estimate pricings on four different options to handle current and estimated growth ranged from \$800,00 to \$2,400,000. The City will carefully weigh each option and use this information to plan out a budget for the coming years. On the clean water side of things, the water plant had to replace one of the aging air compressors. This new compressor is more energy efficient than the previous compressor. All though the exact numbers can't be calculated, the operators at the plant have already noticed this unit running about 50% less than the old one.
