Report Title: Water & Wastewater Treatment Department Report June 2025

Report Highlight: Testing on the Wastewater Plant's discharge water for Whole Effluent

Toxicity (W.E.T.) has been completed and the results received in accordance to our permit. This test is performed by taking our treated wastewater and placing live fish in the sample. The fish must first of all survive but also grow and reproduce in the sampled water in a laboratory located in Carrollton, Texas. Test results showed that our water met the requirements under the US EPA Standards for discharged water (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) coming from a wastewater treatment facility. It is an annual test performed on our water to ensure that the effluent leaving the plant meets the safety requirement not only for humans but also aquatic life in our streams and rivers.
