Report Title: Water & Wastewater Treatment Department Report November 2025

Report Highlight: Georgia Power has restored the electricity to the Wal-Mart Lift Station as well as the Raw Water Intake. Due to the new footbridge being installed at the reservoir, power poles had to be relocated. Both facilities have been operating off of diesel fueled pumps and motors since the start of the project. With normal operations in place, preventive maintenance service has been performed on the standby generator to insure its reliability for the next emergency event. The rental pump for the lift station is being returned to the supplier. The two borrowed generators from GRWA are being stored in the old transfer station across from the WWTP. This site has been offered to them for a dry storage area until another community system needs them.
